



## DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO ACHILL ISLAND

### **DUBLIN TO ACHILL**

Starting at Lucan, follow the Lucan Road (N4) signposted 'The West, Lucan'. Continue forward onto Leixlip Bypass - M4 (signposted Sligo, M4). Through the Toll Plaza continue along N4 past Rathowen and Edgeworthstown to Longford. At Longford roundabout take the 1st exit onto Ballymahon Road (N4), at next roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the N4 and continue on N4 entering Longford town.

At roundabout take the 1st exit onto Dublin Road (R393). Continue forward onto Dublin Street (N5). Turn left onto New Street (N63). Continue forward, then turn right onto Ballymahon Street (N63). Continue forward onto Main Street (N5).

Follow the N5 entering Strokestown, at roundabout take first left (N5) and continue through Tulsk and Bellinagare to Ballaghaderreen. Take sharp right turn, following the N5, and continue along the Charlestown bypass through Bohola to Castlebar.

At Castlebar take the second exit (straight ahead) at the first roundabout, signposted Westport. At next roundabout (junction with N60) take 2nd exit (straight ahead), and at the third roundabout (junction with R311) take the second exit (turning right), signposted R311 Achill and Town Centre. At the fourth and final roundabout, take the second exit (straight ahead), and turn left at next junction (signposted Achill). Follow this road (R311) to Newport, turn right at junction with N59 through the village, follow N59 through Mulranny.

From Mulranny, follow signs for Belmullet (N59) for one mile, then branch left onto R319 signposted Achill. You will shortly arrive in the parish of Achill. For Achill Island, simply follow the R319 through Tonreege and Polranny. Achill Island is connected to the mainland by a road bridge at Achill Sound.

### **BELFAST TO ACHILL**

From Belfast city centre follow signs for motorway M1. Take M1 motorway (signposted Dublin, Craigavon, The West) for approx. 60km and continue forward onto the A4 (signposted Enniskillen, Omagh)

Continue along A4 for approx. 90km, through Ballygawley, Augher, Clogher, Fivemiletown, past Brookeborough and Lisbellaw to Enniskillen. Follow signs for A4 and continue through Letterbreen and Belcoo to the border with the Republic.

Follow the N16 (signposted Sligo) for approx. 26km to Sligo, then take N4 (signposted Dublin). Continue forward for approx. 15km and take the N17 (for Castlebar, Galway). Continue on N17 through Charlestown, then turn right onto N5 (signposted Castlebar). Proceed on N5 through Bohola and Bellavary.



At Castlebar take the second exit at the first roundabout, signposted Westport. At next roundabout (junction with N60) take 2nd exit, and at the third roundabout (junction with R311) take the second exit, signposted R311 Achill and Town Centre. At the fourth (final) roundabout, take the first exit (straight ahead), and turn left at next junction (signposted Achill). Follow this road (R311) to Newport, turn right at junction with N59 through the village, follow N59 through Mulranny.

From Mulranny, follow signs for Belmullet (N59) for one mile, then branch left onto R319 signposted Achill. You will shortly arrive in the parish of Achill. For Achill Island, simply follow the R319 through Tonragee and Polranny. Achill Island is connected to the mainland by a road bridge at Achill Sound.

### SHANNON AIRPORT & LIMERICK TO ACHILL

From Shannon Airport follow signs for Limerick and Galway (N18 & N19). Proceed along N19, straight ahead at roundabouts at junctions for Free Zone West and Shannon Town Centre. At the junction with N18, take roundabout 1st exit (signposted Galway, Ennis) onto N18.

Follow N18 through Clarecastle, Ennis, Crusheen, Gort, Andrahan, Kilcolgan and Clarinbridge.

At junction with N6, take 2nd exit on roundabout for the N6. Proceed straight ahead at junction with N18 (North), then at junction with N6 East and N6 West, take 2nd exit on roundabout. At junction with R339, take 2nd exit on roundabout. At junction for Galway City East, go straight ahead on roundabout. At junction with N17, proceed straight ahead on roundabout. At junction with N84, take 3rd exit on roundabout onto the N84 (signposted Castlebar, Headford).

Follow N84 through Clonboo, Headford (turn right), Shrule, Kilmaine, Ballinrobe, Partry, Ballintubber and Ballyhean. At junction for N60, go straight ahead onto N60 to Castlebar.

In Castlebar, at the junction with the N5, take 1st exit at roundabout (signposted Westport, Achill). At the next roundabout (junction with R311) take the second exit, signposted R311 Achill and Town Centre. At the fourth (final) roundabout, take the first exit (straight ahead), and turn left at next junction (signposted Achill). Follow this road (R311) to Newport, turn right at junction with N59 through the village, follow N59 through Mulranny.

From Mulranny, follow signs for Belmullet (N59) for one mile, then branch left onto R319 signposted Achill. You will shortly arrive in the parish of Achill. For Achill Island, simply follow the R319 through Tonragee and Polranny. Achill Island is connected to the mainland by a road bridge at Achill Sound.



## GALWAY TO ACHILL

From Galway city centre, follow signs for N84 (signposted Castlebar, Headford).

Follow N84 through Clonboo, Headford (turn right), Shrule, Kilmaine, Ballinrobe, Partry, Ballintubber and Ballyhean. At junction for N60, go straight ahead onto N60 to Castlebar.

In Castlebar, at the junction with the N5, take 1st exit at roundabout (signposted Westport, Achill). At the next roundabout (junction with R311) take the second exit, signposted R311 Achill and Town Centre. At the fourth (final) roundabout, take the first exit (straight ahead), and turn left at next junction (signposted Achill). Follow this road (R311) to Newport, turn right at junction with N59 through the village, follow N59 through Mulranny.

From Mulranny, follow signs for Belmullet (N59) for one mile, then branch left onto R319 signposted Achill. You will shortly arrive in the parish of Achill. For Achill Island, simply follow the R319 through Tonragee and Polranny. Achill Island is connected to the mainland by a road bridge at Achill Sound.

## WEXFORD TO ACHILL

From Wexford city centre, follow R769 towards Waterford. At the New Ross Road roundabout, take 2nd exit onto N25, follow through Ballynabola, New Ross and Glenmore to Waterford.

In Waterford, follow signs for Dublin, Limerick N9 to leave by Newrath Road. At junction of N9 and N24, turn left onto N24 (signposted Limerick). Proceed through Mooncoin and Carrick-on-Suir, following signs for Clonmel (N24). Continue along N24 through Tipperary and onto Limerick.

From Limerick follow N18 (signposted Galway, Ennis). Follow N18 through Clarecastle, Ennis, Crusheen, Gort, Ardrahan, Kilcolgan and Clarinbridge.

At junction with N6, take 2nd exit on roundabout for the N6. Proceed straight ahead at junction with N18 (North), then at junction with N6 East and N6 West, take 2nd exit on roundabout. At junction with R339, take 2nd exit on roundabout. At junction for Galway City East, go straight ahead on roundabout. At junction with N17, proceed straight ahead on roundabout. At junction with N84, take 3rd exit on roundabout onto the N84 (signposted Castlebar, Headford).

Follow N84 through Clonboo, Headford (turn right), Shrule, Kilmaine, Ballinrobe, Partry, Ballintubber and Ballyhean. At junction for N60, go straight ahead onto N60 to Castlebar.

## CORK TO ACHILL

From Cork city centre, follow signs for Limerick (N20). Follow the N20 through Rathduff, Mallow, Buttevant and Rath Luirc (Charleville). At junction with N21/R526, take 2nd left slip road to join dual carriageway (signposted Limerick, Dublin). Follow this road (R509) to the junction with the Limerick by-pass. At traffic signals turn right R509 into Limerick Ring Road (signposted City Centre). At Roxborough Roundabout, take 1st exit R511 (signposted City Centre).

From Limerick follow N18 (signposted Galway, Ennis). Follow N18 through Clarecastle, Ennis, Crusheen, Gort, Ardrahan, Kilcolgan and Clarinbridge.

At junction with N6, take 2nd exit on roundabout for the N6. Proceed straight ahead at junction with N18 (North), then at junction with N6 East and N6 West, take 2nd exit on roundabout. At junction with R339, take 2nd exit on roundabout. At junction for Galway City East, go straight ahead on roundabout. At junction with N17, proceed straight ahead on roundabout. At junction with N84, take 3rd exit on roundabout onto the N84 (signposted Castlebar, Headford).

Follow N84 through Clonboo, Headford (turn right), Shrule, Kilmaine, Ballinrobe, Partry, Ballintubber and Ballyhean. At junction for N60, go straight ahead onto N60 to Castlebar.
